WMA QUOTA HUNT INSTRUCTIONS

- You must apply at a TWRA license agent, at any TWRA regional office or by online application at www.tnwildlife.org. If you encounter any problems while applying, please call **615-781-6621** during regular office hours (8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. CDT). **Do NOT mail this form to TWRA.**
- **You may begin applying June 17, 2009. The deadline is midnight, July 22, 2009.**
- You may have up to 15 choices but you will be issued only one permit for each drawing you enter. Do not use the same hunt code choice more than once. You/your party will not be drawn for two hunts occurring on the same or overlapping dates.
- No person may apply more than once. **Exception: Youths, ages 6-16 by the date of the hunt, may apply for both Young Sportsman and regular hunts but these hunts must be applied for on separate applications.** Youths must be accompanied by a non-hunting adult 21 years or older.
- A party must be established by a party leader who will **CREATE** the party, select the hunt choices for the party, and the number of drawings in which they wish to participate. The party leader will also decide whether or not to allow an applicant with lower priority to **JOIN** their party. A party number will be assigned to the leader and anyone wishing to join the party must have that party number when applying. Once the application is complete, the party number will be printed on the receipt. **A party may not exceed 15 members.**
- **Applicants must review their application receipt and verify name, address, hunt locations, party number (if joining a party), fees, etc., upon completion to ensure accuracy.**
- **No applications will be accepted or edited after the deadline.**

WHEN APPLYING AT A LICENSE AGENT:

- You may apply at any TWRA license agent. There is no fee for current Annual Sportsman License holders, Lifetime Sportsman License holders, or Senior Citizen License (Type 166) holders with an Annual Senior Citizen Permit (Type 167). For all other applicants, there is a \$20 permit fee for each drawing you enter plus a \$1 agent fee.
- You will need to provide the license agent with your date of birth and one of the following: a driver's license, TWRA ID, or Social Security Number. If **applying alone** or **creating** a party, you need to know your hunt choices and how many drawings you wish to enter. If **joining** a party you will need to know the party number (which should be obtained from the party leader before applying).
- When applying in person, you must remain until your application is processed to verify that your information is correct and to obtain your receipt with your confirmation number.

WHEN APPLYING ON THE INTERNET:

- There is no fee for current Annual Sportsman License holders, Lifetime Sportsman License holders, or Senior Citizen License (Type 166) holders with an Annual Senior Citizen Permit (Type 167). All other applicants, in addition to the \$2 internet usage fee, will be charged a permit fee of \$20 plus \$.50 per drawing entered. The \$2 internet usage fee is collected by the company that maintains the internet site. (It is not a fee that is charged by the TWRA.)
- Go to www.tnwildlife.org. Click on **"Buy A License Online"** on the right side of TWRA's home page. The next page will say **"Online License Center."** Scroll down to the bottom and click on **"Start Here."**
- You will need to enter your date of birth and one of the following: a driver's license or social security number.
- If **applying alone** or **creating** a party, you need to know your hunt choices and how many drawings you wish to enter. If **joining** a party you will need to know the party number (which should be obtained from the party leader before applying).

WMA DRAW INFORMATION:

1. A computer drawing will be held to determine successful applications based on the priority drawing system. If any hunt quota remains unfilled after the drawing, a second drawing will be conducted to fill the quota. The priority drawing system is exclusive to the first drawing. Priority is not considered in the second drawing.
2. **Priority Drawing System:** TWRA's priority drawing system gives priority points (maximum of 4 points) to hunters based on the number of years they have participated without being drawn for a hunt. Applicants who were successful last year will start over with a priority of zero. In order to be drawn with priority, applicants **must** apply either alone or in a party in which **all** applicants have the same priority status. If a party includes a member with a different priority, that party (and all its members) will be drawn at the lowest priority of the application.
3. Drawing Procedures: Using the "luck of the draw" method, an applicant or party of applicants is randomly selected by the computer. The first hunt choice is compared to the vacancies that may exist for that hunt, and if there is a vacancy, they are assigned that hunt. If not, the second choice, etc. (in order), are examined until the applicant or party is assigned a hunt or runs out of hunt choices.
4. Successful and unsuccessful applicants will be notified by mail. Unsuccessful applicants' permit fee(s) will be refunded. Receipt and deposit of permit fees do not constitute permission to participate in the hunt.
5. **Permits are not transferable. No refunds will be made after the drawing to anyone issued a permit.**
6. After all the drawings are held, leftover permits will be sold by all license agents and on-line on a first come, first serve basis beginning on September 9, 2009.

* ANTLER RESTRICTIONS

- Catoosa** (all hunts) - Bucks must have at least 4 antler points, 1 inch or longer, on one antler or a 15-inch minimum outside antler spread.
- Laurel Hill** (all hunts) - Bucks must have at least 5 antler points, 1 inch or longer, on one antler or a 15-inch minimum outside antler spread.
- Presidents Island** - Bucks must have at least 9 antler points, 1 inch or longer.
- Yuchi** (all hunts) - Bucks must have at least 4 antler points, 1 inch or longer, on one antler or a 15-inch minimum outside antler spread.
